WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff is requesting that \$31,000.00 in funds be appropriated from URGENT Forfeitures Reserves to increase appropriations of \$31,000.00 for the URGENT vehicles line AA.3989.1907.2100.2140; and

WHEREAS, these funds have been received as proceeds from URGENT cases only and do not include any County dollars; and

WHEREAS, funds for vehicles will provide the URGENT division with better equipped vehicles and are only be used for the benefit of investigating drug and gang criminal cases; now, therefore be it
