WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the Ulster County Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, the salary as stated in the 2021 Ulster County Budget for the position of Opioid Use Disorder Systems Specialist is \$ 62,972.00; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office was awarded \$900,000.00 in COSSAP Grant funds for the term of 10/1/2020-9/30/2023 to cover the expenses and salaries of the program; and

WHEREAS, in order to remain competitive in hiring, and have an experienced person to fill this position, is necessary to increase the annual salary of the Opioid Use Disorder Systems Specialist by \$9,022.00; and

WHERERAS, the Ulster County Sheriff's Office has reallocated salary funds within the COSSAP Grant to cover this cost, a grant modification was not needed due to the overall grant amount staying \$900,000.00; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Opioid Use Disorder Systems Specialist 2021 annual salary is changed to \$ 71,994.00 effective upon hire date; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that if funding for this position is eliminated, the Commissioner of Finance shall, immediately upon discovery, send written notification to the Clerk of the Legislature, and the relevant Department Head shall attend the next regular meeting of the Ways & Means Committee to assist the Committee in review and evaluation for determination of the position's continuance,

and move its adoption.
