WHEREAS, an insurance recovery totaling \$14,782.31 has been received in connection with damage to a 2005 Zodiac Raft and equipment sustained during a September 5, 2015 rescue attempt on the Esopus Creek that resulted in the 2005 Zodiac Raft and equipment being destroyed; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used to replace the destroyed 2005 Zodiac Raft and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff's Office requests that the insurance recovery proceeds be appropriated for use in the replacement of the destroyed 2005 Zodiac Raft and equipment; now, therefore be it
