

**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A Lease Agreement With Access: Supports For Living Inc. For Office Space To Provide Mental Health Services To The Community – Department Of Public Works (Buildings And Grounds)**

Chairman of the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee, Dean J. Fabiano, offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, Access: Supports For Living Inc. (“Access”) is a domestic not-for-profit corporation which has supported the families and communities of the Hudson Valley by providing services for people facing the challenges of disability and mental illness for over 50 years; and

WHEREAS, the present lease agreement between the County and Access for office space at the premises located at 50 Center Street, Ellenville, NY, expired on June 30, 2018, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature to enter into a lease agreement with Access to lease 126 square feet of office space at 50 Center Street, Ellenville, NY for a five-year term beginning November 1, 2018 and ending October 31, 2023, at an annual cost of \$11.00/square foot, totaling \$1,386.00 annually; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute a lease agreement and any amendments thereto with Access, for office space at 50 Center Street, Ellenville, NY for a five-year term beginning November 1, 2018 and ending October 31, 2023, at an annual cost of \$1,386.00 for the five-year term of the lease, as filed with the Clerk of the Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and move its adoption.
