

**Resolution No. 522      September 19, 2023**

**Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For \$19,890.00, Causing The Aggregate Contract Plus Amendment Amount To Be In Excess Of \$50,000.00, Entered Into By The County – Rehabilitation Support Services, Inc. – Department of Mental Health**
