The Commissioners discussed aspirations and aims for an "ideal" map with the understanding these may not all be possible or practical in the final map.

## **Considerations for COR Mapping**

- 1. Use block groups when creating districts;
- 2. Use aerials as much during the process;
- 3. Keep district numbering in the general current order;
- 4. Keep Denning, Hardenburgh, Shandaken, and Olive as one district (0% deviation);
- 5. Keep the City of Kingston boundaries intact by creating three City districts;
- 6. Keep each of the three Villages (Saugerties, New Paltz, Ellenville) whole and, where necessary, expand the village district into its host municipality;
- 7. Keep the remaining municipalities whole by limiting districts to two per municipality as much as possible; and
- 8. Consider that the geography and topography may match more in an adjacent town than to the rest of the town to which it belongs; for example, reservoir linkages, mountains and valleys (Marlborough, Lloyd, Esopus Wawarsing, Route 9W and the Hudson River corridor, the Rochester 209 valley link to Marbletown and Wawarsing, and the mountain areas in Rochester to Wawarsing and Marbletown.

Commissioners then collaborated on making a map but did not complete one.
