

Confirming Reappointment Of Members To The Hudson River Drinking Water Intermunicipal Council

Chairman of the Energy, Environment and Sustainability Committee, Chris Hewitt, and Deputy Chair Richard Walls offer the following:

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 546 adopted on December 19, 2022, authorized the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature to execute an agreement with the Hudson River Drinking Water Intermunicipal Council (Hudson 7) and Dutchess County to include Ulster County as a voting member of the Hudson 7; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 546 of 2022 the Ulster County representatives to the Hudson 7 shall be appointed for each calendar year by the County Executive, subject to confirmation by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to act as the primary representative for Ulster County to the Hudson River Drinking Water Intermunicipal Council for a term to begin immediately and expire on December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has reappointed the following individual to serve as the alternate Ulster County representative on the Hudson River Drinking Water Intermunicipal Council for a term to begin immediately and expire on December 31, 2025:
